SAN JUAN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2023 AT 6:30 P.M.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Austin Lashley. Present were Commissioners Scott Fetchenhier and Pete Maisel, County Attorney Dennis Golbricht and Administrator William Tookey.

Grady Hamm of Silverton Mountain was present to introduce the new owners of Silverton Mountain Ski Area to the Commissioners. CEO Andy Culp provided the Commissioners with a brief introduction to the new ownership group and their immediate intentions. It was the consensus of the Commissioners to schedule a work session with the new group to discuss the future of Silverton Mountain.

Minutes: Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to approve the minutes of September 13, 2023, with the correction that State be added to the first sentence to the 6th paragraph for clarification. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

James Whiting was present representing Cascade Village. Mr. Whiting is requesting a Letter of Support and up to \$5000.00 in grant match for towards a Colorado State Forest Service Grant to do fire mitigation at Cascade Village. Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to provide a letter of support and to authorize up to \$5000.00 in cash match for the fire mitigation grant. The County would match Cascade Village dollar for dollar up to \$5000.00. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The County received a request from Ty Churchwell of Trout Unlimited to provide to our Congressional Delegation letters of support for the proposed Good Samaritan Legislation. Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to provide the letters of support. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A Public Hearing was held to receive comment concerning creating Commissioners Districts that would be in compliance with the 2020 Population Census. Upon completion of the public hearing Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to adopt Resolution 2023-09 to accept the Commissioner Districts as represented in Option A. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The 2023 San Juan County Property Assessment Study was presented to the Commissioners for their review. Commissioner Maisel moved to approve the 2023 Assessment Study as presented. Commissioner Fetchenhier seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Memorandums of Understanding with the State of Colorado for Control of Confidential Data for San Juan County Sales Tax, Lodgers Tax and Retail Marijuana sales tax was presented to the Commissioners for their review. Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to enter into the MOUs and to appoint County Administrator William Tookey to receive that confidential information. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
