- Bill payment assistance
- MUST APPLY FOR LEAP FIRST IF YOU QUALIFY
- Once a year program – you can only apply once from October 2019-September 2020
- One application per household
- Will pay 2 bills totaling \$1000 or less (usually propane and electricity)
- Completed application, Photo ID, and the bill that needs paid are required
- Return to the Social Service Office

Commodities Distribution: Last Tuesday of every month unless otherwise posted

- Must qualify by income before receiving
- Limited amounts available/restrictions will apply
- Processes may be changed due to COVID-19
