SAN JUAN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING WEDNESDAY, May 22, 2024 AT 6:30 P.M.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Austin Lashley. Present were Commissioners Scott Fetchenhier and Pete Maisel, County Attorney Dennis Golbricht (via Zoom) and Administrator William Tookey.

Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to approve the May 8, 2024 minutes as presented. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Kristy Cunningham and Cariss Snyder of the Colorado Division of Veterans Affairs were present via Zoom to provide the Commissioners information concerning the requirements for a County Veterans Service Officer. The Veterans Service Officer must be an Honorably Discharged Veteran, work 1000 hours per year and receive training to achieve Accreditation. Veterans Affairs provides reimbursement to the County at the rate of \$11.12 per hour.

Emergency Manager Jim Donovan provided to the Commissioners, serving as the Board of Health, a proposed Emergency Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement for Local Colorado Public Health Agencies. Upon the Board of Health's completion of the review Commissioner Maisel moved to approve the Emergency Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement as presented. Commissioner Fetchenhier seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

County Administrator Tookey presented the Commissioners with the May Sales Tax Report.

The Treasurers monthly report was presented to the Commissioners for their review.

The Commissioners discussed the options for providing heat for the Miners Hospital Building. Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to approve Option #3-Distributed heating system using electric resistance heating units such as cabinet heaters, unit heaters, cove heaters, etc. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to go into Executive Session for the purposes of considering the possible acquisition of real property and possible formal action related thereto following executive session, consistent with CRS 24-6-402(4)(a) and (e). Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The Commissioners went into Executive Session at 8:28 pm with Attorneys Dennis Golbricht and Rebecca Almon and Administrator Tookey.

The Commissioners reconvened their regular meeting at 9:16 PM.

Commissioner Fetchenhier moved to approve the proposal from SH Environmental Consulting LLC – Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in the amount of \$14,500. Commissioner Maisel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:18 P.M.

Event Highlights:

1. Vern Parker Art Auction: Delve into the world of Vern Parker's western scene oil paintings, an exclusive auction featuring works generously donated by his son Allen Parker. Vern Parker was born in May, 1889, to James Madison Parker, wagon master and blacksmith, and Anna Bills, in Hanford, California. He and his twin sister were the last of seven children. Little is known of his early years.

He became best-known as a painter and woodcarver in the 40s and 50s when he carved gates and signs for the wealthy ranchers and landowners in Santa Ynez, California. His carvings remain on display at the Santa Ynez Historical Museum, and a stagecoach carving can still be seen above the entrance Mattai's Tavern, former stagecoach stop, now a popular restaurant in Los Olivos, California.

He then moved to Benson, Arizona where he had a studio and gift shop with his wife and stepson for many years. The walls of the Horseshoe Cafe in Benson hold his murals and can still be seen there.

It was in Benson that his exquisite horse paintings became published as postcards by Petley Studios in Phoenix. The postcards are still very popular and collectible. Parker eventually moved to Silverton, Colorado and was a colorful town figure as an artist and woodcarver, having his own studio and gift shop for over twenty-five years.

For many years, he divided his time among Silverton, Benson and Tucson, but finally settled in Silverton where he died July 4, 1978. His ashes are scattered at Animas

Forks, Colorado, a ghost town near the Continental Divide. Proceeds from the auction will directly benefit SJCHS, enabling us to continue our mission of preserving and promoting Silverton and San Juan County's rich heritage.

- 2. Local Silverton Youth Art Exhibit: Celebrate the creativity and talent of Silverton's youngest artists with a captivating exhibit showcasing their vibrant works of local architecture.
- 3. Tour the Museum and Jail: Immerse yourself in history with self-guided tours of our world-class museum and jail. From exploring artifacts that chronicle Silverton's past to stepping inside the cells of yesteryear, this is an opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of our town's heritage over the past 150 years.

Title 12, Article 43.4, Part1) by its acceptance of such Local License hereby agrees, undertakes, and covenants to hold and save harmless, release, and indemnify San Juan County, its Board of County Commissioners, the San Juan County Local Licensing Authority, and their officers, directors, employees, contractors and agents, and all other persons or entities associated or affiliated with San Juan County, all jointly and severally (collectively, the "County"), from and against any and all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, damages, injuries, and/or rights of action, of any nature whatsoever, that are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with the County's issuance of a local license to the undersigned pursuant to the Colorado Retail Marijuana Code and San Juan County Ordinance 2014-01 For Licensure of Retail and Medical Marijuana Establishment.

The undersigned understands and acknowledges that by signing this Retail Marijuana Local Licensee Indemnification Agreement the undersigned has given up certain legal rights and/or possible claims that the undersigned might otherwise assert or maintain against the County. The undersigned also understands and acknowledges that this Indemnification Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Colorado and that if any portion hereof is held invalid, the undersigned agrees and understands that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

The undersigned understands and acknowledges that this Indemnification Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the undersigned and the County relating to the subject matter herein and that it cannot be modified or changed in any way by the representations or statements of the County, or by the undersigned.

Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed as waiver or diminishment of any protections, limitations, rights or immunities available to the County by any provision of Colorado law, including, without limitation, any protection or limitation of liability under the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, C.R.S. § 24-10-101, et seq.

In the event that a controversy, dispute, litigation or arbitration emerges over this Indemnification Agreement, venue and jurisdiction shall be proper only in San Juan County District Court. The County shall have the right to recover reasonable attorneys fees and costs it may incur to enforce this Indemnification Agreement.




