## COVID19 TESTING SITE TO BE ESTABLISHED IN SILVERTON COLORADO

San Juan County Public Health received COVID-19 tests this week from the Colorado Department of Public Health Environment (CDPHE). Testing is expected to begin May 4th in Silverton for those that qualify. Call 970-387-0242 to schedule a test.

In order to best allocate the limited number of tests, patients must meet the following criteria to qualify to be tested:

- 1. Have <u>active symptoms of COVID-19</u>, such as shortness of breath\*, fever, cough, chills, sore throat, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell
- 2. Have a Doctor's Order
  - Those without a primary care provider can call the Silverton Clinic at 970-387-5114 to arrange consultation via tele-health.
  - Patients can also search for a provider on the <u>tele-health and nurseline directory</u>: <u>https://covid19.colorado.gov/telehealth-nurselines-directory</u>
- 3. Patients should self-report symptoms through the CDPHE intake form. https://intake-app-dot-cdphe-erm.appspot.com/intake-form

Two types of nasal swab tests will be available in Silverton. PCR tests are sent to CDPHE in Denver. Results are typically expected in 24-72 hours. Point of Care tests deliver results onsite in 5-15 minutes.
