

Civil Rights Complaint Form

You have the right to equal access to services, if you are an applicant, client or member of the public trying to gain access to Social Services program information or benefits. The San Juan County Department of Social Services has a civil rights complaint procedure that provides prompt and thorough resolution of civil rights complaints.

Civil rights complaints allege discrimination. You have a right to file a civil rights complaint if you believe you have been discriminated against because of your race, color, ethnic or national origin, ancestry, age, sex, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, religion, creed, political beliefs, public assistance status or disability.

It is against the law for anyone who works for or contracts with the San Juan County Department of Social Services to retaliate against a person who files a complaint or who cooperates in the investigation of a civil rights complaint.

You should submit this complaint within sixty (60) days of the date the alleged discrimination occurred. Please see the County Civil Rights Plan, provided with this Complaint Form, for more information regarding the complaint resolution procedure, as well as alternative ways to file a complaint.
