County Assessor

The goal of the assessor's office is to help taxpayers understand the property tax system. The assessor's duties are to uniformly and equitably arrive at assessed valuation on all property located within her jurisdiction, except Public Utilities which are assessed by the Property Tax Administrator. All real and personal property, not exempt by law, is subject to taxation. It is the owner's duty to see that it is listed with the County Assessor.

These values are then certified to all taxing boards by the Assessor. The levies are determined and certified by each Taxing Board to the Board of County Commissioners. All property tax is collected locally and used to fund the services provided by each taxing entity.

During the month of May, owners may protest the property value or the classification established by the assessor. Notices of Valuation indicating the change in the actual value of your property will be mailed the first week of May 2017. This new value will be used in the calculation of your property taxes that will be due in January of 2018. The Notice of Valuation contains information about your legal right to challenge your property's 2017 classification or value.




